Katie Vanden Avond Named Recipient of Rummel Collegiate Achievement Award

De Pere, Wis. – De Pere Rotary announced that Katie Vanden Avond, a recent graduate of St. Norbert College, is the 2016 recipient of the Collegiate Achievement Award for the Lee Rummel Sports Awards. Katie joins Packers President & CEO, Mark Murphy who will receive the Distinguished Service Award. The awards will be presented at The 2016 Lee Rummel Sports Awards Banquet on Thursday November 17th from 6:00-10:00 p.m. at the Swan Club located at 875 Heritage Rd., De Pere, WI 54115. The public is invited to attend.

The numbers do all the talking for Katie Vanden Avond's soccer career at St. Norbert College. Vanden Avond's 130 career goals in just 78 games is the most ever scored by a NCAA Division III player, and the second-most scored by a collegiate player at any level. Vanden Avond led NCAA Division III in goals three times – 2011, 2013 and 2015. A four-time first-team All-Midwest Conference selection, she was also a three-time Midwest Conference Offensive Player of the Year. She finished her career with 130 goals and 21 assists for 281 points. She was a twice named an All-American by D3soccer.com and once by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA).

The Lee Rummel Sports Awards banquet was established in 1998 by the De Pere Rotary Club with the approval, support and participation of Lee Rummel, serving at that time as the Green Bay Packers Director of Public Relations.
